



## **FAME public charter school reports its highest API scores**

FAME Public Charter School, now in its fifth year, has recorded its highest Academic Performance Index (API) growth score since its inception with an API growth score this year of 743. Serving a predominately new immigrant community from the Middle East and Southeast Asia, FAME has shown continued academic improvement, particularly with its English Language Learner (ELL) student population. It exceeded its API growth target and increased the percentage of students reported as "proficient" or "advanced" in all subject areas.

FAME's success in serving Alameda County's underserved immigrant community is success for all county schools.
